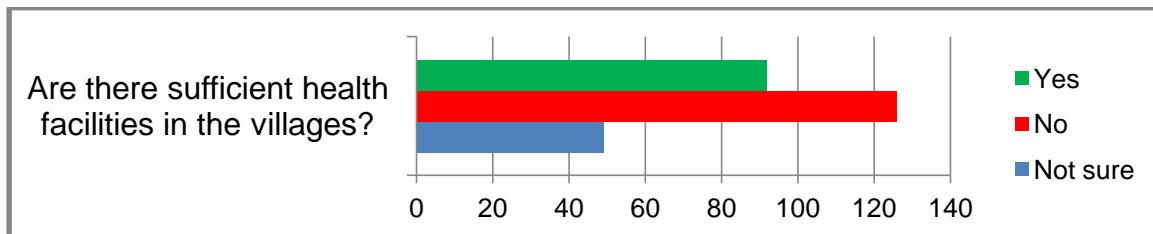

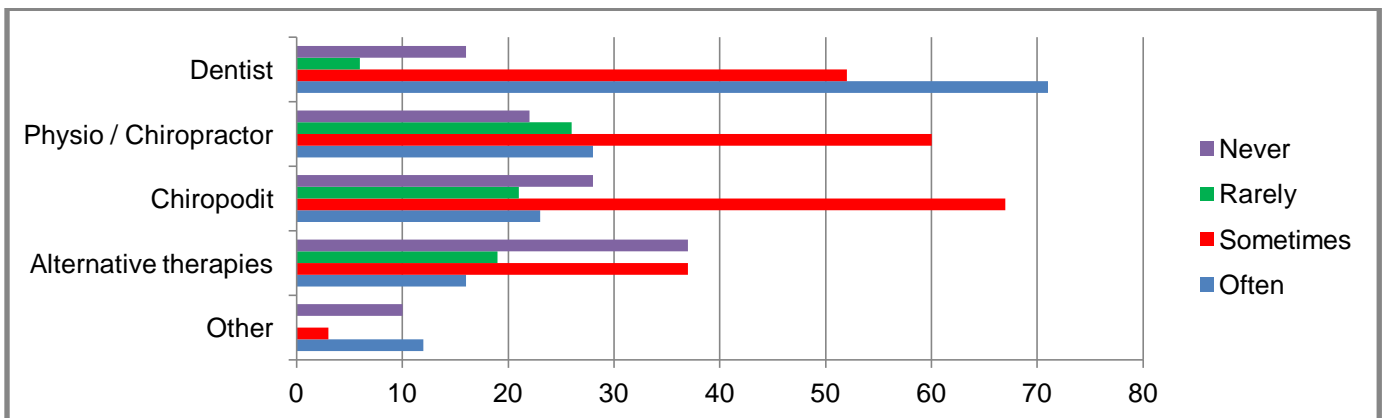
Q8 Are there sufficient health facilities in the villages?

A larger doctor's surgery with more doctors – too many people go out of the village for this. There would also be other of the above (practitioners) one or two days a week – in other words extending the services which already exist at the doctors' surgery

Do not use local GP as do not think it complies well with infection control and is not disabled friendly. Midwife and Health Visitor Service no longer in Parish either.

Despite being registered, I do not use the existing services enough To judge but have heard negative feedback about them

A charity shop in the village would be good and would mean that the villagers could meet more people either by working in the shop or using it. Sad to see the Dunkirk "Goods Shed" gone

Chinese Restaurant, more restaurants, café, organic food

Whatever happens we should seek to retain a Health Centre / surgery within the villages
