Data Protection Policy

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS 2018 (GDPR)

B&DNP Group holds limited personal data.

Permission to hold personal data (for example email addresses) is gained from parishioners before being used. Any group email communications (for example to advertise B&DNP Group events) are sent using “blind” copies in order that the email addresses (personal data) are not disclosed.

B&DNP Group privacy notice can be viewed on the website.

Making sure your data is safe

GDPR is designed to create common privacy requirements across the EU. It is a development of existing data protection legislation and is based on seven key principles that can be summarised as:

- Personal information held by B&DNP Group will be processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.
- Personal data will only be used for specific and legitimate purposes.
- The information held by B&DNP Group shall be limited to what is necessary.
- Information shall be accurate.
- Information shall be held no longer than is necessary.
- Information shall be kept safe and secure.
- B&DNP Group is accountable and can demonstrate compliance with GDPR.
